Minutes

Attendance: Bob Moulton, Roberta Roth, Jeff Cox, Francisco Porras, Brian Chongtai, Karen Brown.

System-wide Video Streaming – Brian Chongtai stated they've had requests for video streaming and wanted to know what the other institutions were doing and if there was any interest in a system-wide video streaming service. Roberta said WNC and GBC were currently using Real to provide the streaming service with SCS acting as the contract agent. Roberta said she was certain UNLV had a contract with Real. She suggested he contact Lori for more information on how NSC could participate. She also said she'd be available to having video streaming discussions with Brian on SCS' contract. Roberta asked Francisco what CSN was doing but his comments were inaudible. Bob said if there was general interest he would be willing to take it forward and see what they could do on an NSHE wide contract to get a better deal. This will be on the agenda at the August meeting for further discussion. Brian will wait to hear from the other institutions to see what they are doing and Brian will move forward.

Future of legacy application- FIN/HR – Roberta Roth spoke to Robyn Render about the future of the legacy applications. Robyn would prefer to attend the August CTO meeting to discuss the current state of the legacy applications. She also proposed moving the August 26, 2009 meeting to 9:00 a.m. to accommodate her iNtegrate schedule. Robyn's discussion will cover the implications and risks of the technology and the software for FIN and HR. Roberta asked if those in attendance were still interested. NSC, CSN and UNLV will be there. Bob said a message would be sent to the CTO's informing them of this request with an agenda to follow.

Email accounts by institution – Lori Temple requested a follow up to the information Roberta presented at the last Advisory Group meeting on SCS' current e-mail volume. Roberta pointed out that NSC's section included SCS, GBC, CSN and System Administration. The column reading 'number of accounts' represents the number of active accounts and not the total number of accounts created over time. The columns reading 'actively reading' and 'actively forwarding' are the number of accounts that are truly active and are receiving mail from SCS.

Jeff said a representative from Google had contacted him. He will forward the e-mail to Chris Gaub since there is a representative assigned to NSHE.

Communication Plan – This discussion was tabled to the next meeting due to not all the institutions being present and the room not being equipped for the presentation; however, everyone has received a copy of the handout. Roberta said the presentation will focus on awareness, understanding challenges in communication and the direction NSHE is heading to develop a better set of communication plans.
